REID ATKINSON VISUAL PERFORMANCE (INDIVIDUAL)

Reid Atkinson is an active arranger, program coordinator, and educational consultant for bands across the country and is proud to serve as the program coordinator for Carolina Crown.

Prior to transitioning out of the classroom, he served as the Marching Director at Vista Ridge High School. In addition to overseeing the marching program, his teaching responsibilities included conducting the Wind Symphony and coordinating the student leadership program. During his time at Vista Ridge, the Ranger Band continued its long history of success. Notable highlights include being named the 2018 UIL 6A State Champions as well as finalists at BOA Austin, medaling at the San Antonio Super Regional, and being named BOA Grand National Finalist.

Reid resides in Leander, TX, with his wife Alison and his two children, Ainsley and Paxton.

KYLE MILLER VISUAL PERFORMANCE (ENSEMBLE)

Like many, Kyle Miller's experience begins with high school performing arts. From that vital introduction, his love of performing arts continued to grow. He greatly values his opportunities to work with WGI, DCI, BOA for over 20 years. He also serves as Judge Coordinator for Midwest Color Guard Circuit, and is serves as a facilitator with DCI's visual captions. Based in Las Vegas Nevada, he teaches English Language Arts, and advises the Forensics team and yearbook publications class. Moreover, he continues to find ways to creatively blend curriculum with performing arts.



OMAR CARMENATES MUSIC PERFORMANCE (ENSEMBLE)

Omar Carmenates is currently the Associate Professor of Percussion at Furman University in Greenville, SC where he oversees all aspects of the percussion program including classical, jazz, and world percussion studies. In addition to his duties at Furman, Omar is an avid participant in the marching arts whose work can be seen and heard around the globe. While currently serving as an adjudicator for WGI Sport of the Arts, he has also served as a composer/arranger for the Cadets, the Boston Crusaders, the Spirit of Atlanta, and the Beatrix (Hilversum, Holland) Drum & Bugle Corps and has also acted in various teaching capacities at the Phantom Regiment, the Spirit of Atlanta, and the Boston Crusaders. Additionally, he has been the percussion arranger for high school programs across the United States including the Bands of America Grand National Champion Tarpon Springs High School Outdoor Performance Ensemble.

Omar is also a versatile musician with a strong interest in performing and recording contemporary solo and chamber music. His debut solo recording, entitled The Gaia Theory, was released through Rattle Records in 2013 and he can also be heard on the Cantaloupe Records release of John Luther Adams' concertlength Inuksuit for 9–99 outdoor percussionists, a work that he both cocommissioned and directed in its United States premiere. He is also the director, producer, and arranger of the "John Psathas Percussion Project", a multi-year collaboration aimed at recording and performing percussion ensemble arrangements of the works of New Zealand's most prominent composer, John Psathas. The recordings and scores from this project are published through PARMA Records and Promethean Publications respectively.

Under his direction, the Furman University Percussion Ensemble has become known for its performances and recordings of ecoacoustic music, helping promote Furman's standing as one of the nations academic leaders in sustainability. Most recently, the ensemble received major support from the David E. Shi Center for Sustainability to collaborate with composer Matthew Burtner on the premiere recordings of his Six Ecoacoustic Quintets and Avian Telemetry, a new interdisciplinary work written expressly for the ensemble. Students of the ensemble have also presented interdisciplinary performances and research at the Percussive Arts Society International Convention, the Ecomusics and Ecomusicologies conference, the nief-norf Summer Festival Research Summit, the International Conference on Romanticism, and the Esri International GIS User Conference.

Omar holds a Doctor of Music degree from Florida State University, a Master of Music Degree in Percussion Performance from the University of North Texas, and a Bachelor's degree in Music Education from the University of Central Florida, and is a proud endorser/artist for Grover Pro Percussion, Vic Firth, Inc. Remo Drumheads, Zildjian Cymbals, and Pearl Corporation/Adams Musical Instruments.



DYLAN TOOMBS MUSIC PERFORMANCE (INDIVIDUAL)


Dylan Toombs is an arranger, consultant, and clinician for numerous bands from across the country. He is a brass specialist in the Dallas Fort-Worth metroplex, where he maintains an independent studio of middle-school through college-aged students. His students consistently win positions within the Texas All-State ensembles, the Greater Dallas Youth Orchestra, and countless other drum corps and collegiate ensembles.

Dylan currently serves as the Brass Coordinator for the Bluecoats Drum and Bugle Corps. He has previously held titles as Assistant Brass Caption Head of The Cavaliers, and lead brass instructor of Carolina Crown. Dylan has been a part of six Jim Ott high brass awards as well as a two Drum Corps International World Championships.

Dylan earned his degree from the University of North Texas in Music Performance with a concentration in Euphonium Performance. During his educational endeavors at the University of North Texas, he was honored to study with the world-renown Dr. Brian Bowman. Dylan now serves as the co-principal euphonium for the Dallas Brass Band and plays with the Dallas Winds on occasion.

Toombs co-founded and serves as the music arranger for Collective Marching Designs, a distinguished marching design team that focuses on bringing fresh and achievable productions to groups across the country.

When not performing, teaching Dylan enjoys spending time traveling with his wife and daughter.





JASON ROBB EFFECT (MUSIC)

Jason Robb is a freelance visual designer, program coordinator, and educational consultant living in Austin, Texas. He received his Bachelor of Music in Education and Trumpet Performance from Sam Houston State University in Houston, Texas.

Before transitioning to pageantry design full-time, he had a successful career as a band director in Texas. He began his career teaching middle school band in The Woodlands for 5 years. In 2013, Jason relocated to Cedar Park, Texas to join the band staff at Cedar Park High School, capturing a UIL Texas State Marching Championship in 2015. In 2016, Jason accepted the position of Director of Bands for Rouse High School in Leander, Texas. Under his direction, the Rouse program has been a Bands of America Regional Finalist, Regional and Super Regional Class Champion, and 5A UIL State Marching Championship Finalist. Jason was named the Phi Beta Mu Texas Young Bandmaster of the Year in 2018. He was inducted into the Alpha Chapter of Phi Beta Mu in the spring of 2020.

He has served on the instructional faculty of the Madison Scouts from Madison, Wisconsin, serving mainly as a high brass specialist. Jason returned to Madison to serve as the Program Coordinator in 2020. Jason also serves as the Educational Director for Forward Leadership, a program offered by the Madison Scouts. Jason is also an active clinician and adjudicator, presenting educational clinics and serving as an adjudicator for organizations around the country.

MICHAEL STONE EFFECT (VISUAL)

Mike Stone resides in West Hills, California and has been adjudicating various pageantry competitions since 1997. He attributes his interest in pageantry to his high school music and marching band program. Mr. Stone has studied, performed and taught in several music programs in California. He is recognized at the highest level of adjudicators for Drum Corps International, Winter Guard International and Bands of America. Currently Mr. Stone serves as the Executive Director for the WGASC in Southern CA. Drum Major for the band is Kaitlyn Suthers.






Red Regime
